Reason For Selection	A relay calculator with a program function. A program unit with six plastic 60-tooth gears enabled users to set their own programs and perform automatic calculations with preset calculation sequences. The unit was demountable and multiple calculation sequences could be interchanged as necessary. It was marketed at ¥ 995,000 and was widely adopted by government offices and universities. A valuable piece that demonstrates the course of development in the era before the electronic calculator.
