Reason For Selection	In 1947, after the war, Japanese sewing machine manufacturers collaborated to put together the "HA1 type sewing machine standard drawing" under the auspices of the Japan Sewing Machinery Manufacturers Association, and the machine was manufactured by various companies as the HA-1 type based on this drawing. This standardization contributed greatly to the performance, quality, and mass production of Japanese sewing machines. The selected machine was made by Mitsubishi Electric Corporation (currently JUKI TECHNOSOLUTIONS CORPORATION), which had been manufacturing sewing machines since before the war, and the instruction manual from that time has been preserved. It is significant as an example of the reboot of the sewing machine manufacturing industry after the war.
