Reason For Selection	Pine Sewing Machine Co., Ltd.'s (currently JANOME Corporation) Model 30 (Pine 100 type) was manufactured with reference to the Singer 15 household sewing machine. The Model 30 (Pine 100 type) was virtually the first private sector product in Japan for which the division of mass production of the sewing machine parts was adopted. After the war, this production system was further developed and laid the foundation for the "inter-firm division of production system" network that was highly regarded by the General Headquarters, the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers (GHQ-SCAP) at the time. The Model 30 (Pine 100 type) is significant for having ushered in the "inter-firm division of production system," which also had a tremendous impact on the development of postwar Japanese industry.
