Reason For Selection	This telephone set supported the post-high growth era. Also known as the last rotary dial phone. In order to respond to the rapid rise in prices caused by the 1973 oil crisis and the changes in society due to the end of high growth, the company achieved significant cost reduction and high maintainability for the product, and it was produced by multiple companies. In addition to adopting a mounting structure that assumes manual assembly in consideration of resource saving and a future decrease in demand, this telephone set was significant in view of the global market, satisfying two international standards, one derived from voice intelligibility and the other derived from communication volume.
