Reason For Selection	The world's first video camera to have electronic image stabilization. Hand-held video footage is unpleasant to view, as the whole screen shakes. This video camera was the first in the world to solve this problem by using an electronic image stabilization function. Electronic image stabilization technology can be much smaller and lighter than optical image stabilization technology. This was the forerunner for the image stabilization function found as a basic feature on today's digital cameras and mobile phones.
