Reason For Selection	At 0.8mm, this is still the world's thinnest card calculator. At the time, companies were competing to make the calculator smaller and thinner. The pocket size calculator soon emerged, but this was trumped by the development of the ID card and business card sized versions. The thinness was achieved by using a flexible circuit board, LCD panel and solar battery together with film-shaped components. With a 0.5mm LSI, a 0.55mm LCD and a 0.2mm solar battery, this calculator went on sale in 1983 for ¥5,900. One of these calculators – the ultimate in making the calculator smaller and thinner – is on display at the Museum of Modern Art (MoMA) in New York.
