Reason For Selection	As the public and private sectors were carrying out prefabricated construction development, this was the first type of building to grow out of the private sector and become a business success. (1) A pipe house was assembled by columns of 22-27 mm diameter steel pipes and trusses. This structure was first used for storehouses, then for temporary housing. Later it became the basis for steel pipe structured buildings. (2) A midget house was a structure with walls that fit wooded frame panels into C type steel columns, and it was used for a separate structure such as a study room. As a house priced at 118,000 yen that could be built in three hours, it had explosive sales. It is valuable as a pioneer of the prefabricated building technology that blossomed in Japan.
