Reason For Selection	This is a kind of concrete mixer vehicle. This mixer is different from the current type of tilted drum mixer that sets a drum diagonally and revolves agitating fresh concrete. In this type of mixers, a rotary is installed inside the drum. This mechanism forcibly agitates and mixes fresh concrete, and so it produces a higher quality of fresh concrete. At first, mixers were imported from the United States, and fixed up on chassis made in Japan. From 1955 they have been designed and produced in Japan, and 2,512 mixers have been produced. This mixer is one of the specially-equipped vehicles that supported Japan in its high growth period. Along with showing how mixer vehicles developed, it is valuable as an example of the earliest existing type of this vehicle.
