Oi Electric Co. was the company that provided the parametron used for building the MUSASINO-1 computer developed at the NTT's Telecommunications Research Laboratory. From this they ventured into developing small electronic calculators. In 1963, they developed Alephzero 101 for test production, and in the following year sold the second machine built. It has a numerical pad, which is now commonly used, a Nixie tube display, the ability to perform the four arithmetic operations and extraction of square root, and was sold for 800,000 yen. It was developed at the same time as Hayakawa Electric Co. (Sharp)'s All transistor-diode electronic desktop calculator (CS-10A) and is an important exhibit symbolizing the dawn of the development of electronic calculators.
