Reason For Selection	This was the digital camera test model in which image captured by a CCD camera was, for the first time, successfully recorded as digital signal on a memory card. It created still image data from one field or one frame of a movie taken through the video camera. It was able to store ten image fields and five image frames on a 2Mbit SRAM card. It measures $105(W)\times75(H)\times50(D)$ mm and weighs 400 g. Unlike Sony's Mavica (1981), an earlier electronic camera model that stored data in analog format, the FUJIX DS-1P is a direct predecessor of today's digital cameras, and its invention gained for Japan international recognition for its unique scientific and technological advancements.
