Reason For Selection	This is Japan's first commercial transmission electron microscope (TEM). Hitachi constructed two of the microscopes, and this one was installed at Nagoya Imperial University in December 1942, a few years after the university was established. This TEM uses a magnetic field type electron lens. At the time, there were two electron lens options available: the electric field type and the magnetic field type. The fact that all later TEMs likewise adopted the magnetic field type electron lens makes this first commercial electron microscope especially significant.
