Reason For Selection	Japan's early commercially available, mass-produced color television, still in existence. A typical color television receiver showing the technology produced by companies with the advent of color television broadcasting in 1960. The television was based on National Television System Committee (NTSC) standards and used a RCA 21CYP22 color picture tube, 28 vacuum tubes and 2 diodes. These sets weighed 88kg, measured 780mm (W) x 705mm (H) x 721mm (D) and had an electricity consumption of 380W; between 400-500 sets were produced each month at a price of ¥520,000. Around 5,000 color television sets were produced in Japan that year.
