Reason For Selection	The first color film in Japan. The "Outdoor Chromogenic Color Reversal Film" was developed and manufactured by Konishiroku Co., Ltd. (now Konica Minolta Co., Ltd.). This achievement was even more outstanding in that it was only the third such film in the world. The "selected exposure development method" used was a superior method in that it was simpler and required less processing than Eastman Kodak's far more globally popular Kodachrome "osmotic regulation development method". This method later became the main method in use.
